

PEACE AND GOOD ORDER BY-LAW

1. Section 4 of the said By-law is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:
 4. No person or body corporate shall make or permit to be made any unnecessary noise or disturbance by means of the operation of a motor vehicle or any type of machine or equipment.
2. Section 20 of the said By-law is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:
 20. Any person or body corporate who commits any offense under this By-law on conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars or in default of payment to be imprisoned for a term not exceeding twenty (20) days.
3. No person shall within the Town of Port Hawkesbury be on any street, land, thoroughfare, sidewalk nor in any public place, nor at any public gathering or meeting, in a drunken or intoxicated condition nor act thereon or treat in a drunken or intoxicated manner.
4. No person shall make any unnecessary noise or disturbance by means of the operation of a motor vehicle.
5. No person shall perform or engage in any stunt or other activity upon a street or place so as to unduly disturb residents of any such street, place or part thereof.
6. No person shall loiter in or about the front of any place of religious worship, or any place to which the public has access, or in any public place in the Town.
7. No person shall discharge any fire-arm, air gun, BB gun, pellet gun, slingbow (slingshot) or other weapon or dangerous toy within the Town.
8. No person who is not a sweller therein or an inmate thereof shall refuse or neglect to withdraw from a private house or dwelling or place of business in which he may be after being requested to do so by the owner or person having the control or management thereof nor remain in the said dwelling house or place of business after such request to the annoyance of any dweller therein or inmate thereof nor contrary to the wishes of the owner or master or mistress or person having the control or management thereof.
9. No person shall knock or pound on any door or any house or ring any door-bell for the purpose of annoying the inmate thereof.
10. No person, shall on any street, beat any drum or blow any horn or trumpet or

other musical instrument or clang any Tamborine, Cymbal or shout or sing after being requested by any Police Officer to desist from so doing.

11. No person shall knowingly meddle or interfere with any grave, tomb or vault in which the dead are interred; or pluck or take away any flowers of any kind growing or placed upon or around any such grave, tomb or vault.
12. No person shall wantonly deface, unhinge, break or destroy any part of any fence or gate enclosing or partly enclosing any house, lot of land or other place whatsoever, either private or public.
13. No person shall wantonly or unnecessarily ring or blow any fire alarm signal.
14. No person shall willfully or unnecessarily disturb the good order of any public meeting held or any lawful purpose.
15. No person shall unnecessarily annoy any other person by throwing stones, snow-balls, ice, filth, garbage or other matter of any kind on any premises, or into or against any building occupied by such other person.
16. No person under the age of fifteen (15) years shall be or remain upon or in any street of the Town after nine o'clock in the evening unless accompanied by one of his or her parents or guardians or some other adult person authorized for such purpose by one of the said parents or guardians.
17. Any such child found on or in any street of the town unaccompanied as aforesaid in the night time after nine o'clock may be taken to his or her home by any policeman, and the parent or guardian of such child shall be warned by such policeman that if the offence is repeated, said parent or guardian will be liable to the penalties hereinafter mentioned. Said policeman shall keep a written memorandum of such warnings to whom and the date upon which same were given.
18. Should any child, whose parent or guardian has been warned in accordance with the provisions of the next proceeding section, be found again in or upon any street unaccompanied as in section 16 set out, the parent or guardian so warned shall be guilty of an offence against this By-law unless he or she can establish to the satisfaction of the court that he or she has done everything reasonably possible to have the said child comply with the provisions of this By-law.
19. No person shall buy, sell, keep or set off any fire crackers or other fire works within the Town, with the exception that any organization of person may be permitted to put on a display of fire-works if written permission has previously been obtained from the Council.
20. Any person who commits any offence under this By-law on conviction thereof,

shall be liable to a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and on non-payment thereof to be imprisoned for a term no exceeding twenty (20) days.
